

FINA691C Financial Markets in China

Course Description

The course is an overview of China's financial markets, their latest development, and future trends. Topics include: History of China Financial Markets, Structure of China Financial Markets, Regulation and Regulatory Bodies, Foreign Exchange and Monetary Policy, the Peoples Bank of China, Banking Industry, Securities and Bonds Market, Development of the Stock and Bond Market, Development of the Insurance Industry, Private Equity Funds, and the Real Estate Industry.

Learning Objectives

After completing this course, Students should have acquired:

- Knowledge of history and special situation of China's financial system.
- A basic understanding of the current issues, structure, regulation, and future trend of different sectors of the China's financial system.
- Key organizations in each sector or function of the China financial system.

Performance Measurement

There will be no mid-term or final exam. However, a group project (up to three team members) will be assigned for the students to analyze the current situation of one selected sector, such as, banking industry, or function, for example, regulation on IPO, and recommend a proposal about how to improve the situation.
