Bio-sketch of Mr. David Tsoi:

Mr. David Tsoi has worked in the IT industry for over thirty years. He is a specialist in designing large scale stock market trading systems. He was involved in building a number of generations of trading systems for the Hong Kong stock market. Additionally, he has participated in designing and building trading systems for the Shanghai Stock Exchange and the National Stock Exchange of India. The common features of these three stock markets are that the trading volume is huge and the stringent demand for high reliability and availability. Other industries that Mr. Tsoi has active participation are logistics, banking and finance industries.

Synopsis of the talk:

The stock market of China has developed very rapidly in the last few years. Mr. Tsoi will explain some of the basic fundamentals of the infrastructure of the stock market in China. He will further contrast it against the common practices in HK and other western countries. Finally, he will explore with the audience the various career opportunities in the industry.
