Bio-sketch of Dr. Edmund Sun

After receiving his MSEE and PhD in Applied Physics, Electrical Engineering and Business Economics in California Institute of Technology, Dr Sun played an integral role in technological development for General Electric and Hewlett Packard.

From 1981 to 2006, Edmund started 4 ventures, Weitek Corporation, C-cube Microsystems, Digital Video Systems, Inc. and C2 Microsystems, Inc. (3 of them are listed in NASDAQ). Being the innovator of video and graphics processing technology, he was recognized as one of the inventors of MPEG technology and he introduced compression and decompression chip used in satellite and cable broadcast, Video CD and DVD player/recorder. He created China VCD market by working with the China Ministry of Electronic, Tsing Hwa University and WanYen Electorics in Anhwei Province. In 1999, he received the Lifetime Achievement Award in DVD/MPEG technology during the European American DVD Summit conference.

After nearly twenty years of entrepreneurship, Dr Sun worked as the Visiting Professor at National Chiao Tung University business school and Beijing University Information technology graduate school in 2006. Currently, he is the Chair Professor at Academia Sinica and co-PI of Foresight Taiwan.
