

INFORMATION ON IMMUNIZATION

Students that grew up in Hong Kong are well immunized against most preventable diseases by having followed an immunization program that is structured and administered by the Hong Kong SAR Government. As a student coming from outside of Hong Kong, you might have gone through a different immunization program. To ensure that you stay healthy in Hong Kong, you are encouraged to compare your immunization record with Hong Kong's immunization program (see below). If necessary, you should discuss immunization needs with your physician before or upon arrival in Hong Kong.

1 month	Hepatitis B Vaccine - Second Dose
2 months	DTaP-IPV Vaccine - First Dose
4 months	DTaP-IPV Vaccine - Second Dose
6 months	DTaP-IPV Vaccine - Third Dose Hepatitis B Vaccine - Third Dose
1 year	MMR Vaccine (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) - First Dose
1 1/2 year	DTaP-IPV Vaccine - Booster Dose
Primary 1	MMR Vaccine (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) - Second Dose DTaP-IPV Vaccine - Booster Dose
Primary 6	dTap-IPV Vaccine - Booster Dose
