Bio-sketch of Mr. Raymond Cheng:

Mr. Cheng has a distinguished career in the IT field, started with joining HSBC as an IT programmer in 1983. Over years of contribution to the company's development in IT services globally, he is now the Head of IT Hong Kong, who oversees all HSBC IT services for Hong Kong and China.

Mr. Cheng has dynamic experience and knowledge in global e-commerce market. He has worked in New Jersey and Vancouver, totally for five years, in a global e-commerce programme for the whole Bank worldwide. He has ample experience in major process re-engineering and offshore operations projects.

Mr. Cheng manages distributed development teams in different locations and has ample experience in managing sizable global projects involving major countries

HK (China), UK, US and Canada. He led and delivered multi-million dollar projects which include Standardization of Branch Banking Workstations in Asia Pacific, Call Centre Services, Internet Banking Services and eCommerce Banking Framework for the whole HSBC Group.

Mr. Cheng graduated from University of Hong Kong with BSc in Electronic Engineering and got an Individual Programme Diploma from Philips International Institute in Holland.
